Introducing children to Mozart's "Magic Flute"

Renowned conservatory of music and Getinge employee initiative stage special production.

On May 20, 2017, around 70 spectators gathered at the Getinge Showroom in Rastatt for a performance of the project "Myth of the Magic Flute". The Badisches Konservatorium, a state-run conservatory of music, was there to present its very own production of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's "Magic Flute", which featured scholars of local society, Bildungschance Rastatt e.V. The children from Rastatt had previously been given the opportunity to learn the dances for the production, to support the conservatory's singers on the big day. The production was specially adapted for children, with the plot of the "Magic Flute" transferred to the depths of the ocean.



Accordingly, the stage elements and costumes, which had all been designed, built and sewn by children at workshops held by Bildungschance Rastatt, were dazzling and colorful. Among the imaginative designs were fish costumes, shells and even a coral chair. Bildungschance Rastatt e.V. is an employee initiative of Maquet GmbH, the aim of which is to provide educational and cultural programs for the families of the city of Rastatt. In addition, the society awards scholarships for young talents aged 8 to 12.
